

Terms and Conditions

- Stuart and Karen Tinney (The Tinney's) T/A Equine Equity operate an Equestrian training and agistment service in Maraylya NSW.
- The owner or manager agrees to pay all agistment, equestrian training, and other related charges reasonably incurred by The Tinney's. Other charges are noted on The Tinney's rate card.
- The Tinney's have the right to engage a Veterinary surgeon, Farrier, horse dentist or other professional persons thought by The Tinney's or their staff to be necessary or advisable to attend the horse and full cost thereof will be borne by the owner or manager.
- The owner or manager agrees to pay all fees and charges within 14 days of invoice date. Interest of 3% per month will applied in all accounts overdue.
- The owner or manager will be solely responsible for all insurance arrangements of their horse (s) and acknowledges that their horse (s) is at 16 St John's Rd Maraylya (the Tinney's) at their own risk.
- The Tinney's shall not be liable for any loss related to any horse consigned to The Tinney's. This includes injury, accident, sickness, disease or death.
- The owner or manager gives The Tinney's lien over the horse(s) and any progeny born at The Tinney's, for payment of the agistment, training and other charges, which the owner or manager must pay under these terms and conditions. The owner or manger may not remove the horse(s) or its progeny from The Tinney's whilst any amount or fees or charges are outstanding.
- Pursuant to the Impounding of Livestock Act 1994 The Tinney's may sell the horse(s) and or its progeny at public auction or by private sale to recover any monies outstanding for the period of 60 days from date of an account.
- The owner appoints The Tinney's as its attorney with full power to do all things and execute all documents necessary to affect a sale of passing of ownership of the horse(s) and or its progeny.
- If all or any part of any Term and Condition is judged invalid or unenforceable in all the circumstances, it will be deemed to be deleted and will not affect the validity or enforceability of the remaining provisions.
- The laws in New South Wales will govern these Terms and Conditions.
